

1. To enable two-factor authentication, go to **Tools > Preferences** 



2. Open the Security tab, and click on the Two-Factor Authentication sub-tab and click on the lock icon at the bottom of the window to unlock the Settings (you will be prompted to enter your Master Password), then click on the switch to **enable** two-factor authentication.





here but Microsoft Authenticator App can also be used


**4.** Now it is time to use your two-factor **authentication app**. We are going to use Google Authenticator as example

**5.** Tap on **Scan a Barcode** if your mobile device has a camera.


If your mobile doesn't have one, choose **Enter provided key** instead.




