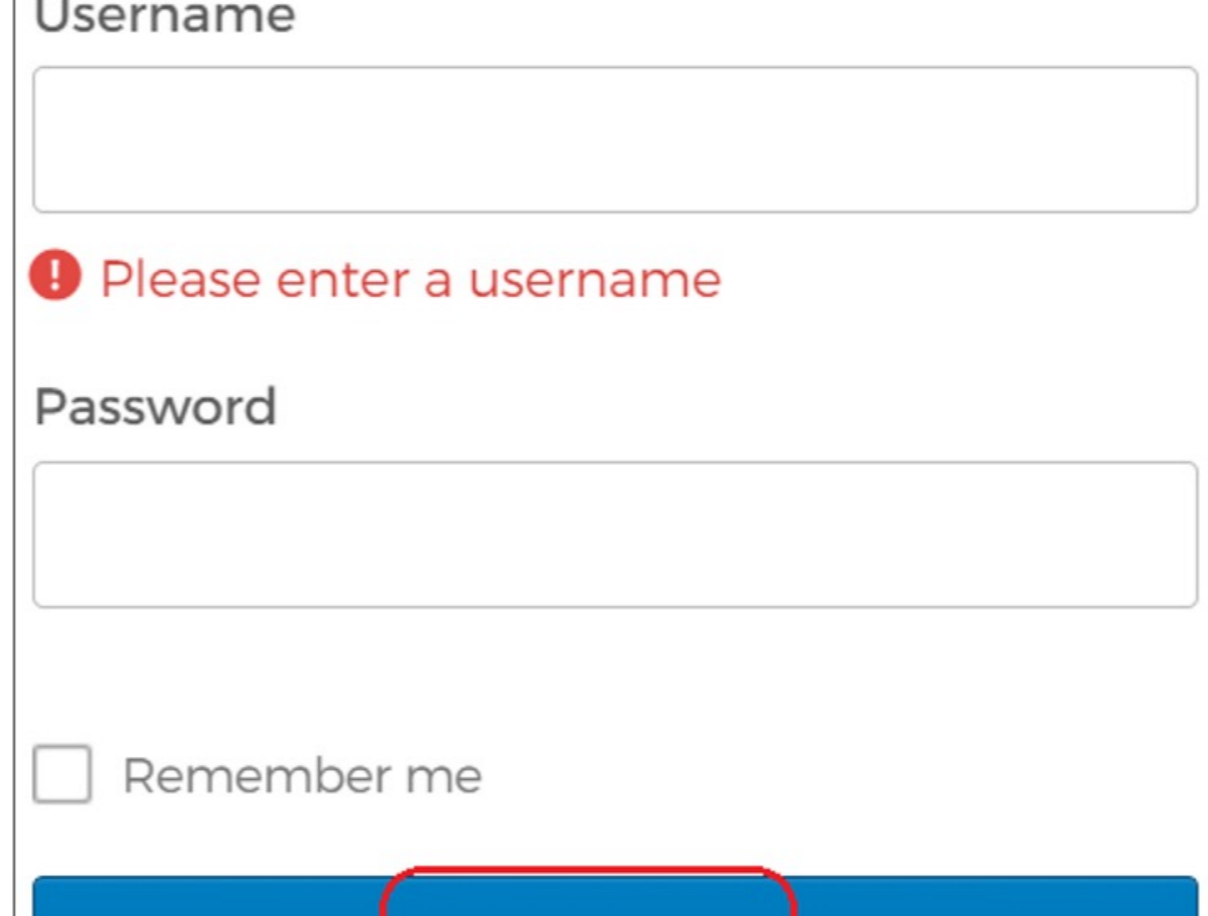

### VeriMark™ OKTA Setup Guide

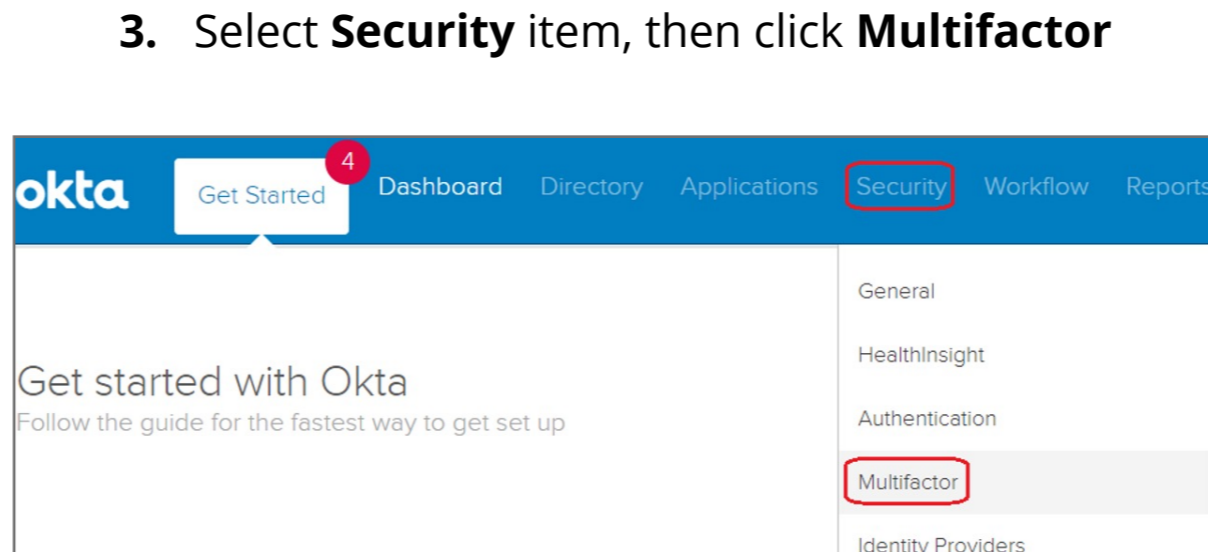
1. Select **Sign In** icon to login your account



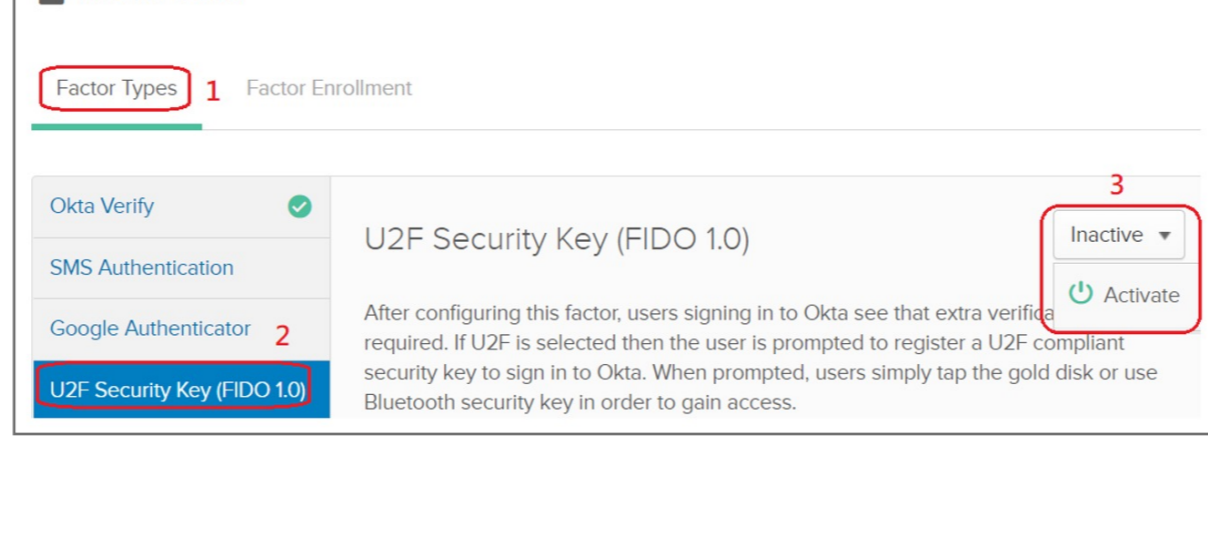
2. Key in your username and password then click **Sign In**



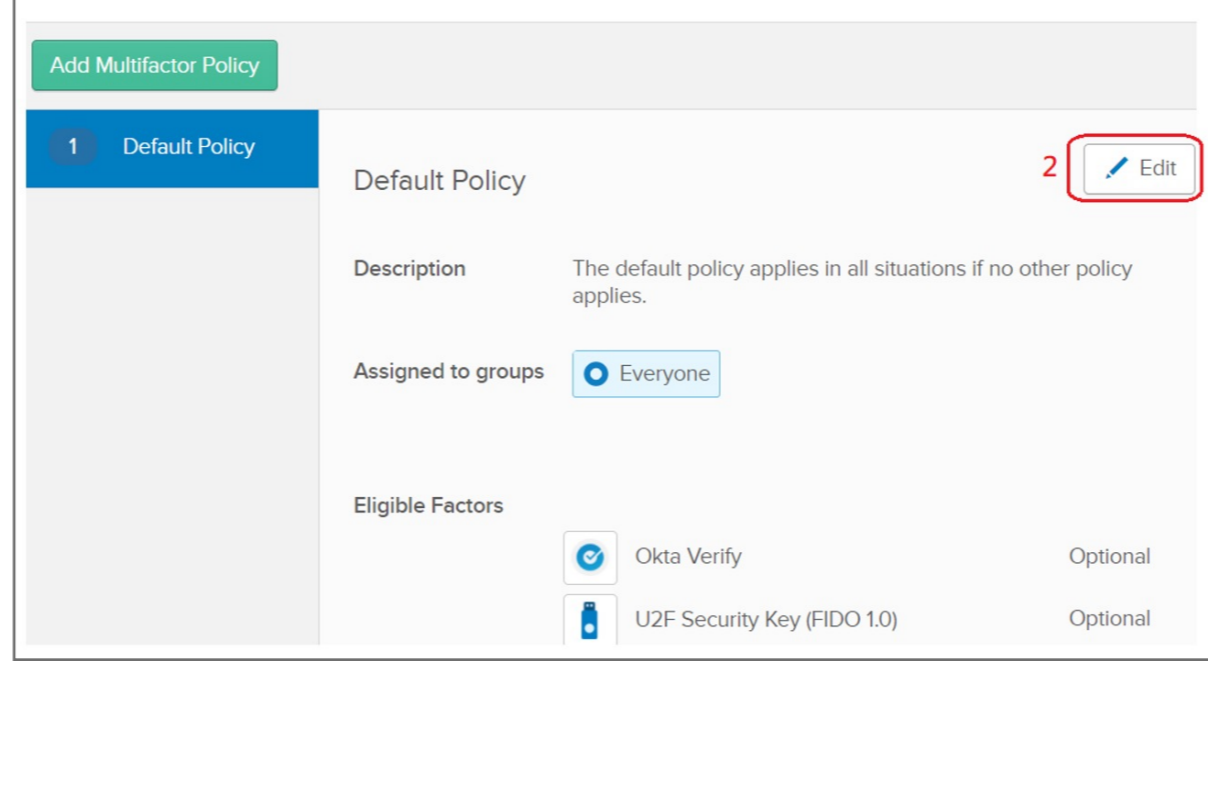
3. Select **Security** item, then click **Multifactor**



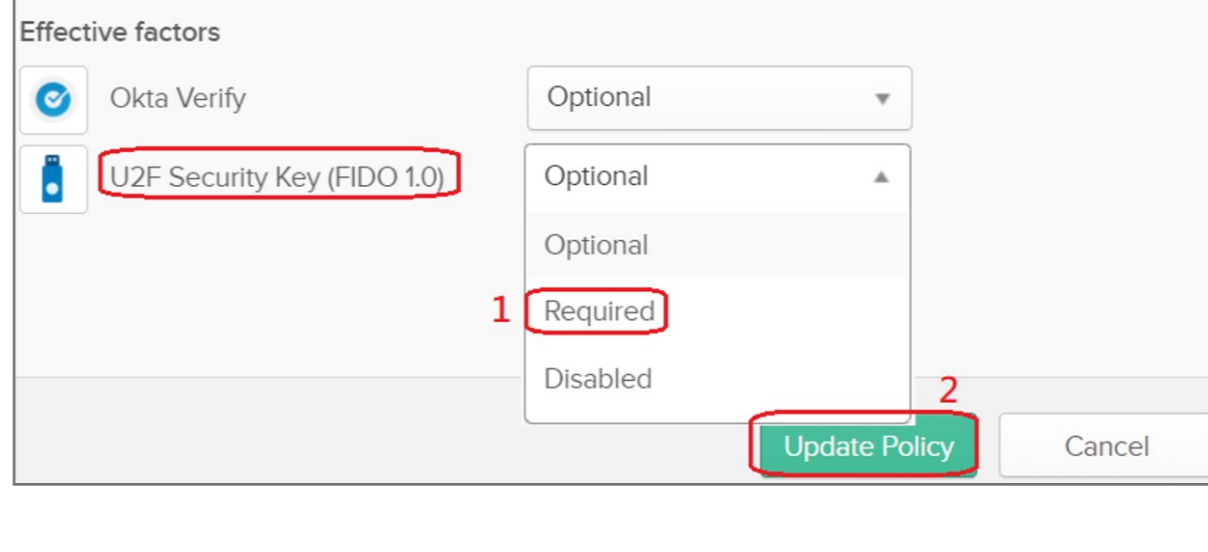
4. Select **U2F Security key (FIDO 1.0)**, then change the status from **Inactive** to **Activate**



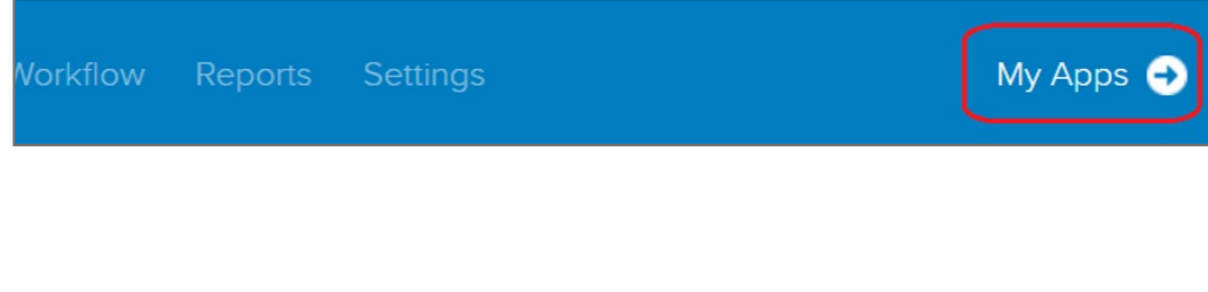
5. Select **Factor Enrollment** icon, then click **Edit** item



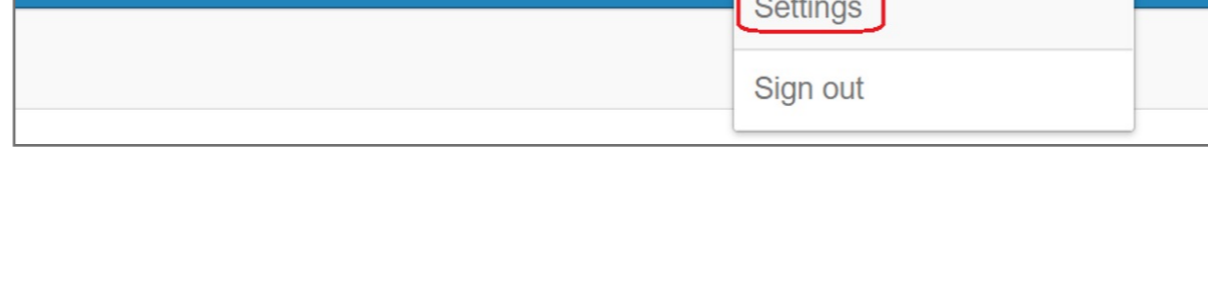
6. Click **U2F Security Key (FIDO 1.0)** drop down menu and select **Required**, then click **Update Policy** button.



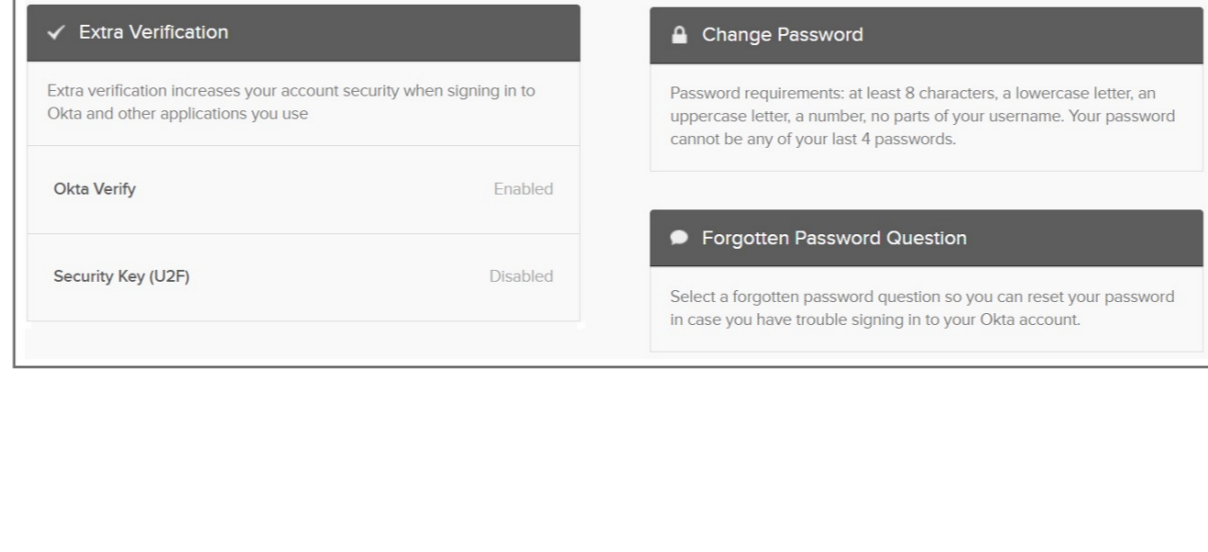
7. Click **My Apps** item



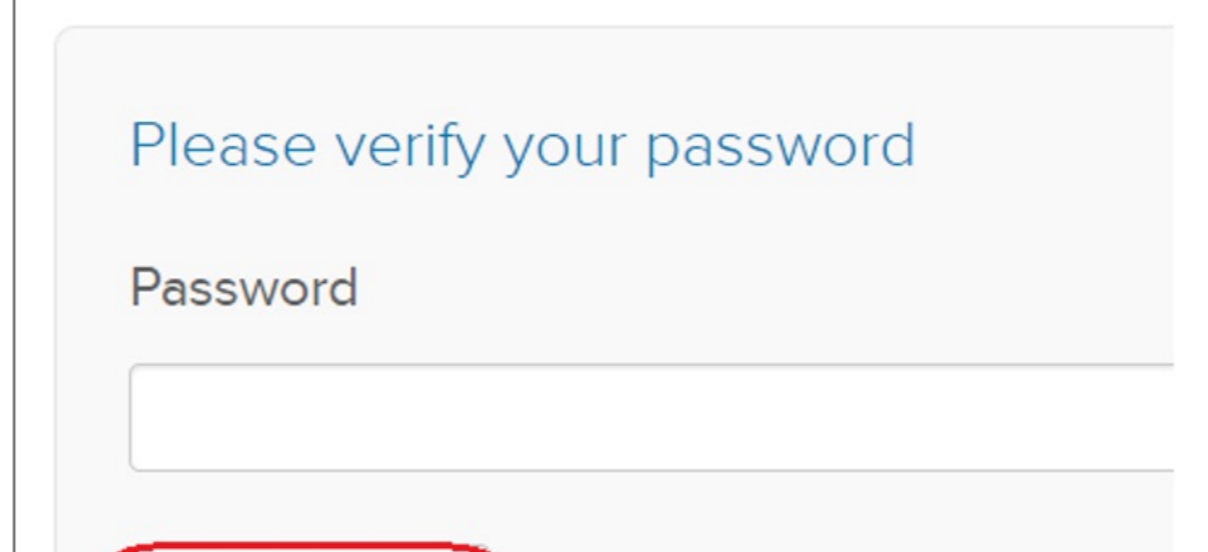
8. Select your account then click **Settings**



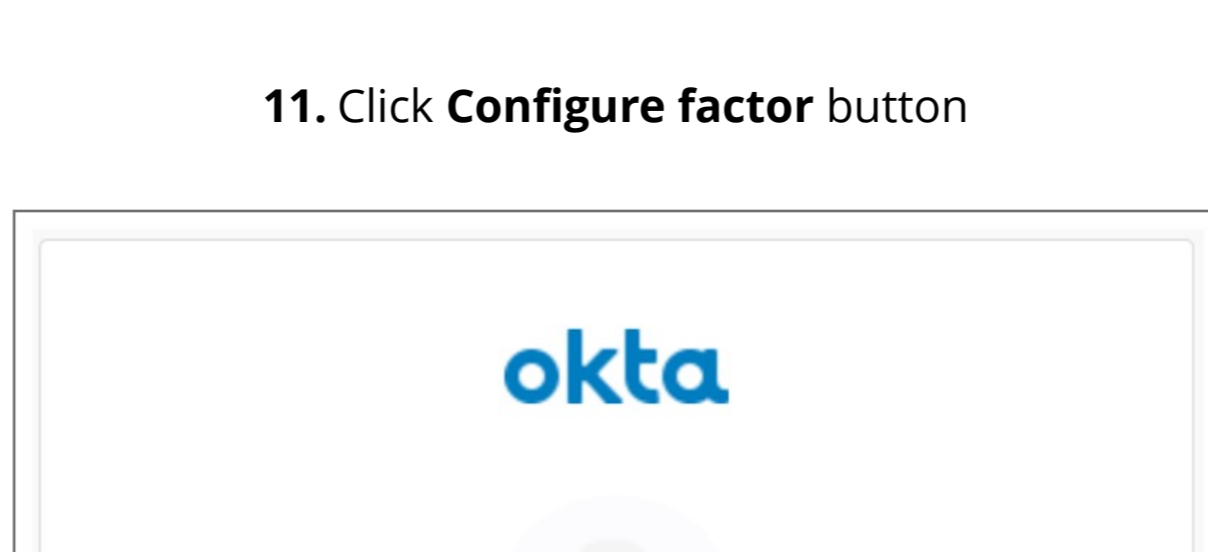
9. Click **Edit Profile**



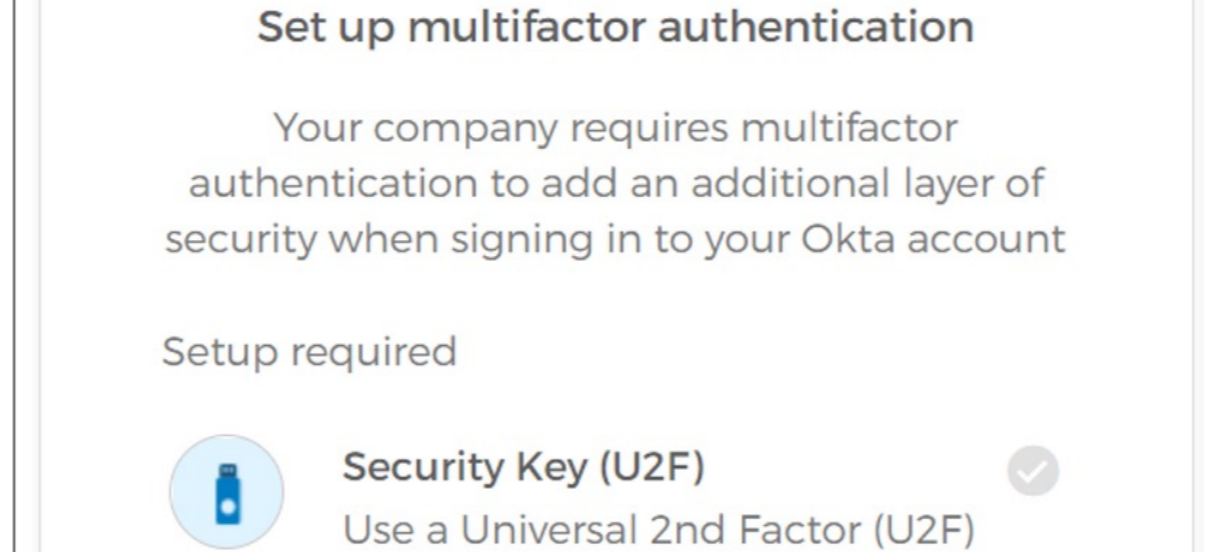
10. Key in your password the click **Verify** button



11. Click **Configure factor** button



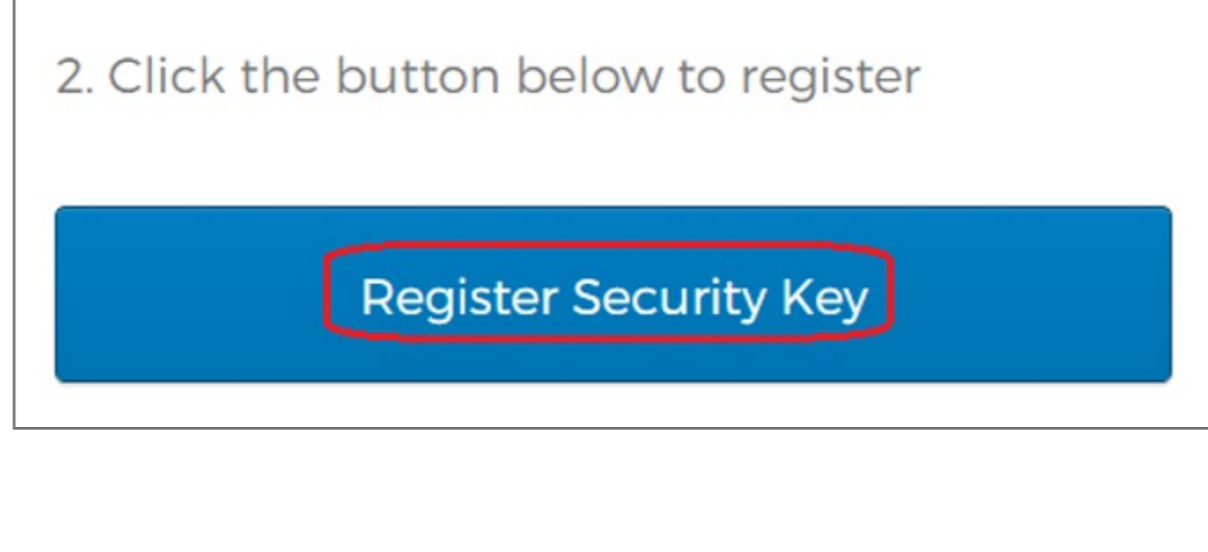
12. Click **Register Security Key** button



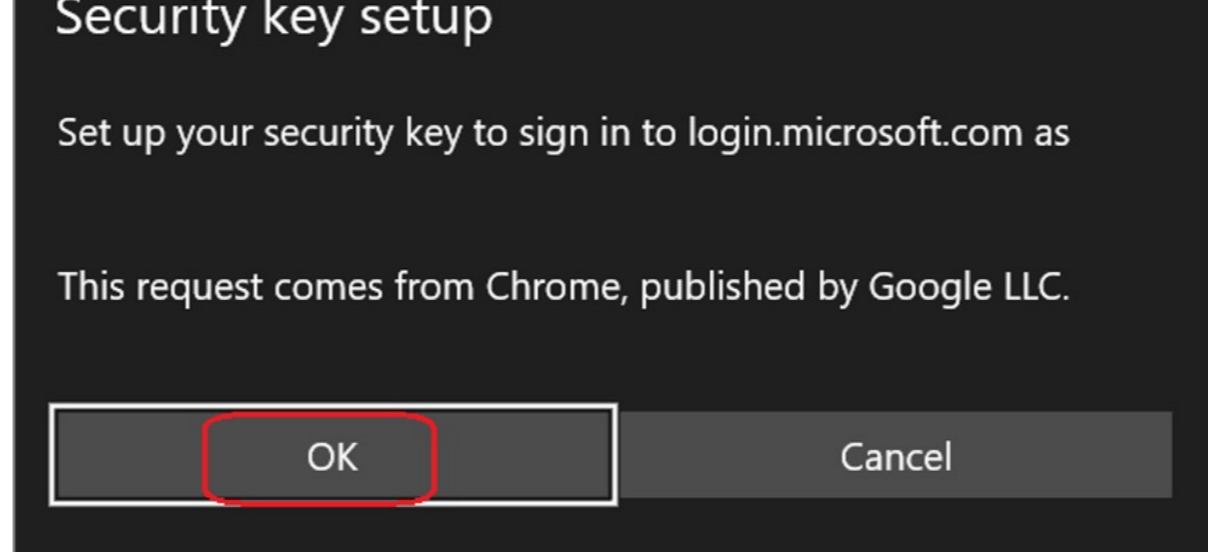
13. Insert your security key then click **OK** button on the opened window to set up your security key



14. Touch your security key with your enrolled finger



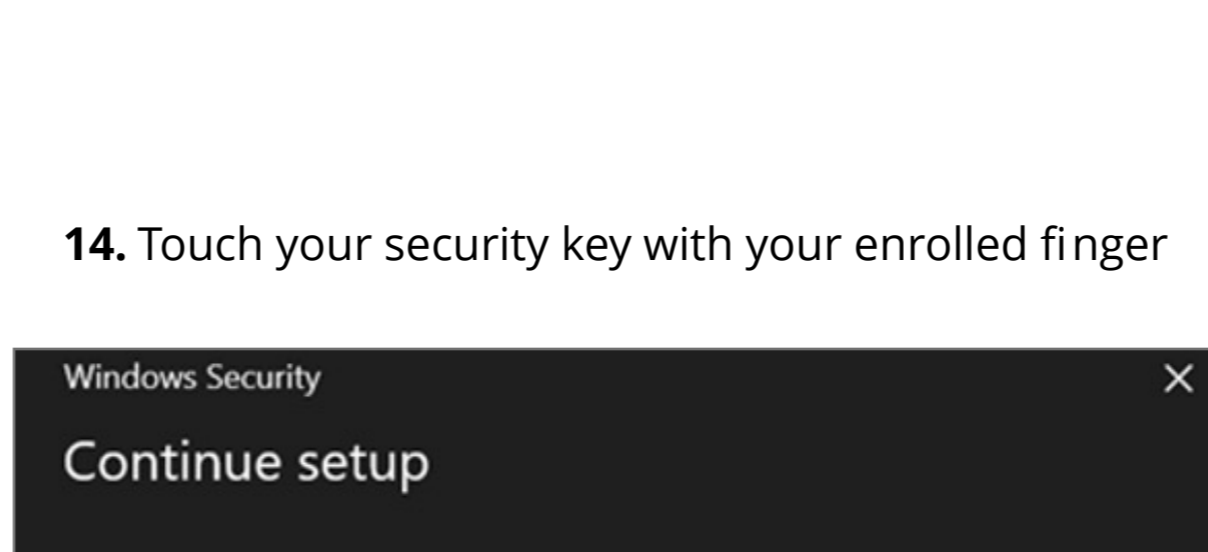
15. Security key setup has completed

1. **Sign in** your Okta account

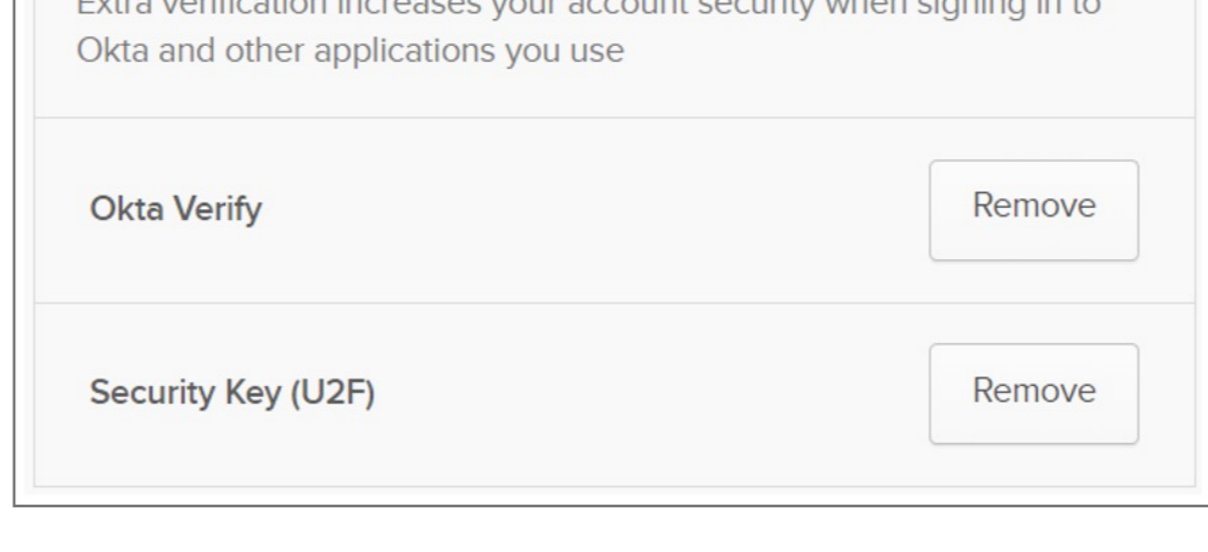
2. Click **Remove** button



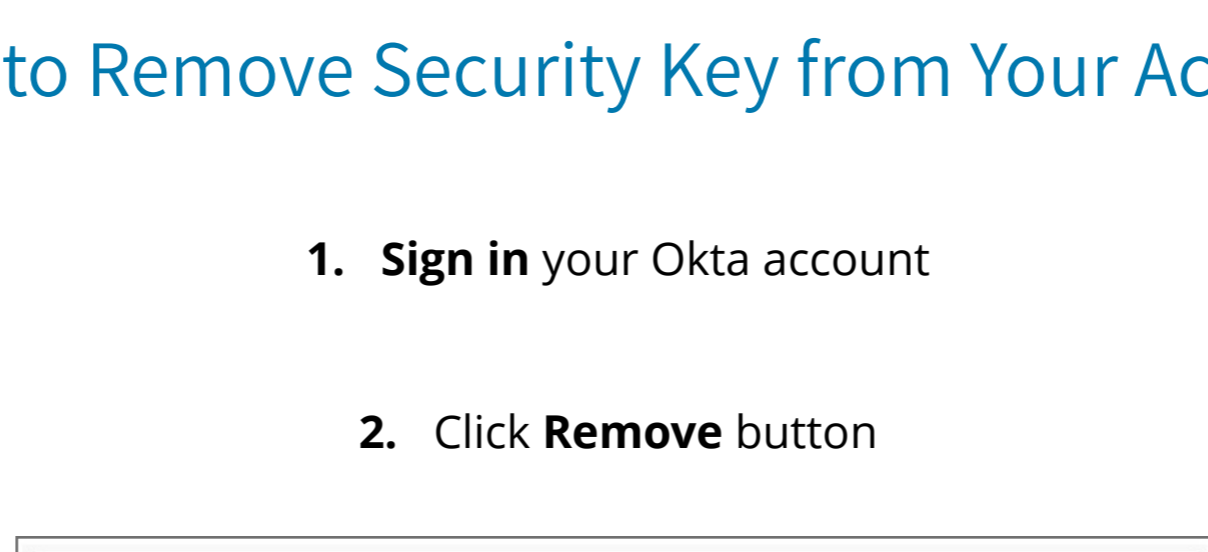
3. Select your account then click **Settings**
