
VeriMark™ Dashlane Setup Guide

1. To enable two-factor authentication, go to **Tools > Preferences**


You **must** download Dashlane application for Windows from the following link. https://www.dashlane.com/download

2. Open the Security tab, and click on the Two-Factor Authentication sub-tab and click on the lock icon at the bottom of the window to unlock the Settings (you will be prompted to enter your Master Password), then click on the switch to **enable** two-factor authentication.




4. Now it is time to use your two-factor **authentication app**. We are going to use Google Authenticator as example

5. Tap on **Scan a Barcode** if your mobile device has a camera.


If your mobile doesn't have one, choose **Enter provided key** instead.






